Whereas George Godfrey late of Charles County was attacked to Injurre unto John Lemarr of a plea of Trespass for that Whereas the said George Upon the Twelveth day of November with the year of our Lord 1679 att Portobasso Creek in Charles County the said John did break and three trees then & there growing of them the said John did fell Cut down and Carry away, and this Cause standing att Issue Ready for a hearing, and the Court seeing it very Necessary (the better to discover and find out by whom the Trespass afor-said is Comitted) that the said Land bee surveyed and Laid out, by some Justices according to the Measur and bound Contained in the Patent, and that a fair plot and Certificate thereof be Returned to the next Provinciall Court, It is by the Court this day Ordered that Randolph Braudt, shall hereby Expressly appointed Impowred and Comanded to Lay out the parcel of Land of the afor-said John Lemarr, Lying on the west side of St. Thomas's Creek in Charles County afor-said according to the ancient Measur and bound thereof in the presence of some Chaudler Sheriff of the County afor-said, who is hereby Comanded and impowred to summon & Impanel a Jury of twelve good Lawfull and honest men of the Neighbourhood to go upon the said Land, and to examine and examine Witness upon oath that the truth of the matter may be fully discovered, to be bring down the Trees afor-said and Decidually to Enquire by Whom the Trespass afor-said is Comitted, & what Damages thereon whome the Trespass afor-said if any shall be found to be Comitted) hath sustained by occasion thereof, and of the falling Cutting down & Carrying away the Trees afor-said, and to Returne a Certificate of the proceedings hereon and a fair plot of the said Land to the next Provinciall Court, to be holden att the City of St. Marys the fifth day of October next att the said Court and of hand and Seal of the said Randolph Braudt, and of the Sheriff and Jurors afor-said, that for his better Justice being fully informed of the truth of the premises may do therein as to Justice shall appertain

Maryland Know all men by these presents, that Thomas Gerrard and Thomas Lemay both of St. Marys County Com. this day (to witt) the two and Twelveth day of July in the fifth Year of the Dominion of y^e Right honorable Charles absolute Lord and Prop^r of the Province of M^e in the year of our Lord god 1680 before me George Talbot one of the Justices of the Provinciall Court, and Confessed Judgment for the sum of fourtene thousand Nine hundred and two pounds of Tobacco obtained ag^t Cap^t Gerrard s^r late of St. Marys County att a Provinciall Court, holden att the City of St. Marys the fourteenth day of May last past, (to say) to the Right honorable the Lord Prop^r upon breach of an Act of Assembly twenty pounds sterl or three thousand pound of Tob, to the same Breagg Inforced upon breach of the said Act twenty pound sterl or three thousand pound of Tobacco, and to the said Breagg for the Damages sustained
