 known for our use and advantage as our said Attorney shall Judge best. Giving
 and granting to our said Attorney by the Title of the said Statute our full and whole
 Power full right and Authority in and about the premises, Upon the Receipt, of any
 Sum or Sums and Sums of Money goods or other Merchandize house Land
 hereditaments or plots whatsoever, or Upon thing touching or concerning of the said
 or any parts thereof, or agreement or Compromise or Contracts whatsoever for the use
 of the said John Swinerton and Hannah my wife as aforesaid according as
 Our said Attorney shall Judge best as aforesaid, He quitances or other discharge Deeds
 of Sale or other conveyances for us and in our Name to make. Seal and deliv, and see
 every other act and ad thing and thing done and done in the Law whatsoever in full
 p^{er}formance to be done in or about the premises in part, or in whole as aforesaid for us and in
 our Name to do. Execute perform as fully largely and simply in every respect to all intents
 purposes and purposes as w^{ch} our self might or could do if we were personally present
 being and granting to our said Attorney full power to Ordaine and appoint our word
 Attorney or Attorneys under him and him or them again to Revoke at his pleasure
