 any estate having or lawfully claiming of in or to y^e premises or
 any part thereof by from or under the said John Perre the father
 and John Perre the sonne or either of them shall & will all the reasonable
 request and all y^e costs and charges of the s^d Wm Digge his heirs
 or Assignes such further & other Assurances & Assurances in y^e law
 for the further & more better Assuring the premises unto y^e s^d Wm Digge
 his heirs or Assignes make & grant and that at any time when
 the same shall be required by the s^d Wm Digge his heirs or Assignes
 acknowledgment of these presents or otherwise howsoever do by him the
 said Wm Digge his heirs or Assignes or his or their counsel learned in
 the law shall be reasonably devised advised or required, provided the
 said Assurances or Assurances be made and done all y^e proper costs and
 charges of the s^d Wm Digge his heirs or Assignes And that the person or
 persons who shall be required to make such Assurances be not compelled
 for the doing thereof to travell further than the City of St. Marys And
