Know all men by these presents that John Brown of Salem in New England
Merchant and trader and firmly bound unto the Right Hon^e: Charles Lord
Baltimore in his full and just sume of five hundred pounds of lawful currant
money of England to be paid to the said Charles Lord Baltimore and his
Executo^r administrato^r or assignee to him without payment with and truly
to be made I bind my selfe my heire my fierce Exectuto^r administrato^r firmly by
these presents In witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and seal
the one and twentyeth day of February anno Domini One thousand six
hundred and eighty.

Whereas her above bounden John Brown on his behalfe of Samuel Shrimpton
of Boston in New England to whom he is attorney and the above named Charles
Lord Baltimore for himselfe thereto agreed to stand to and abide the Judgment
award and finall determination of M^r Chas Edward Tailliet and Col^r William
Stevens Arbitrato^r indifferently chosen by and between the above said
John Brown in behalfe of the said Samuel Shrimpton and the above
named Charles Lord Baltimore on his owne part and behalfe for and
concerning all and all manner of differences and matter of controverie
that haue ever been had made or arisen by and between the said Charles
Lord Baltimore and Samuel Shrimpton aforesaid for or by reason of
any goods heretofore sent or consigned or intended to be sent and
configned by the said Samuel Shrimpton in copartnership between him
and John Brown last of this Province decaid sonne of the above said
John Brownes difference the said Charles Lord Baltimore and John Brown
have mutually choosen made choice of Col^r Vincent Lovre Justice the said
Arbitrato^r shall not consent and agree to compote the differences and
controverie aforesaid for their Umpire finally to conclude determin and
compost the same Now the consideracion of this obligation is such that if the said Samuel
Shrimpton his heire Executo^r and assignee shall well and truly stand to abide
the said Arbitrato^r to keep the finall award arbitrament judgment and determination
of the said Arbitrato^r in case any greate by him made or of the said Umpire in
case the said Arbitrato^r shall not agree to be made and putt in writing under
his hand and seal of the said Arbitrato^r or Umpire aforesaid indenture
to be directed unto the said Charles Lord Baltimore or his assignee
and to the said John Brown on behalfe of the said Samuel Shrimpton within
fourteene daies after the date of this above written obligation But in case the
said Arbitrato^r shall not agree as aforesaid the said Umpirage to be made
and given up as aforesaid within one and twenty dayes after the date of this
above written obligation then this obligation to be void and of none effect
or else to stand and abide in full force and effect.
