

This Indenture made the Fifteenth day of June in the Fifteenth year of his Dominion
 of the Right Honorable Charles absolute Lord and Prop^r of the Province of Maryland and a
 Baron of Baltimore &c and in the year of our Lord One thousand five
 hundred Sixty Nine Between John Edmondson of Talbot County merchant
 of his own part and Nicholas Painter of Calvert County Gent of the other part.
 witnesseth that the said John Edmondson for and in consideration of the sume of
 Two thousand pounds of tobacco to him in hand paid by the said Nicholas Painter
 before the execution and delivery of these presents his Receipt in hand of the said
 John Edmondson doth hereby acknowledge and receipt and of every part and
 parcel hereof doth hereby acquit and discharge the said Nicholas Painter his wife
 and children by these presents hath given granted bargained sold cesteined
 and confirmed And by these presents doth give grant bargain sell cesteine
 and confirm unto the said Nicholas Painter his heirs and assigns for
 ever all that parcel of land called Broadmeadow lying in Talbot County on
 the North side of Ciffer River in a place called Hopewell and adjoyning
 to a parcel of land layd out for John Morgan called Hopewell Beginning
 at the Northeast bound oake of the said land and running for breadth North
 by Ciffer Creek hundred and fifty perche to another markt oake bounded
 on the North by a line drawn west from the said oake Creek hundred and
 fiftie perche on the West by a line drawn South from the end of the West
 line of Creek hundred and fifty perche until it intersect a parralell to
 the said land called Hopewell on the South by the said land on the East by
 the said Creek containing by estimation seven hundred acres more or
 less; Together with all Righes profits benefits and appurtenances
 whatsover thereunto belonging to have and to hold the same with the
 appurtenances unto the said Nicholas Painter his heirs and assigns for
 his and their owne proper use and behoof for ever And the said John
 Edmondson doth hereby for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators
 forever promise and grant to and with the said Nicholas Painter his heirs
 and assigns by these presents that the said Nicholas Painter his heirs
 and assigns shall and may for ever thereafter peaceably and quietly have
 hold use occupy possesse and enjoy the aforesaid parcel of land with the
 appurtenances without the least trouble molestacion taxation or disturbance
 of any person or persons whatsoever lawfully rayning or pescending to have
 any estate right title or interest of in or to the same or any part or
 parcel thereof from by or under the said John Edmondson, and that the said
 parcel of land is and for ever thereafter shall be and continue clear and
 free discharged and acquited by the said John Edmondson his Executors
 and Administrators of and from all and all manner of Rights
 charges and incumbrances whatsoever made or done
 by or from the said John Edmondson In witness whereof the said John
 Edmondson hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year first
 above written.
