This Indenture made the Twentieth day of November in the Fifth year of the Dominion of the Right Honorable Charles Lord Baron of Baltimore or over Maryland Anno Dni One thousand Six hundred and Eighty Between William Goyther of the County of St. Marys in the Province of Maryland Gent and Owen Goyther of the aforesaid County and Province and Elizabeth his wife of the one part And Thomas Spinks of the County aforesaid Planter of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Goyther and Owen Goyther and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the full summe or quantity of Nine thousand pounds of good sound merchantable Tobacco in shew to them the said William Goyther and Owen Goyther and Elizabeth his wife in hand paid by the said Thomas Spinks before the making hereof, the Receipt whereof the said William Goyther and Owen Goyther and Elizabeth his wife do hereby acknowledge, and the said do jointly and severally contract and discharge the said Thomas Spinks his heirs Executors and assigns and every of them forever by these presents and for other good causes and considerations therein moving, have granted, aliened, bargained, sold, conveyed, and confirmed and by these presents for them and their heirs, do jointly and severally grant, alien, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said Thomas Spinks his heirs and assigns forever, All that parcel of land called Owen Goythers being on the Eastern shore in a River there called Potomack, on the Western side of the said River bounding upon a parcel of land formerly surveyed for Benkin Dicks and beginning at a marked oak standing South South west, and running up the said River by a line drawn North north East to a marked Pine for breadth One hundred and fifty perches, and thence running into the woods by a line drawn west north west for length Three hundred and Twenty perches to a marked oak and by a line drawn South South west to a marked Pine One hundred and fifty perches for breadth thence running down to the water upon Benkin Dicks line running East South East Three hundred and Twenty perches containing Three hundred Acres more or less which said tract of land was granted by his Lordships Letters Patent under the great Seal of the Province bearing date the Three and twentieth day of September Anno Dni 1663 unto the above said Owen Goyther together with all houses woods rights privileges benefitts and appurtenances therunto belonging And all Patents, writings, minims touching or concerning the same do have and to hold the said tract of land and premises with the appurtenances unto him the said Thomas Spinks his heirs and assigns forever, free & clear of all incumbrances whatsoever (the rents and services hereafter to become due to the Lord of the fee of the premises only excepted) And the said William Goyther and Owen Goyther and Elizabeth his wife for them and
