Elizabeth his wife and every of them their and every of their tenures and chynges
shall and will warrant and hereby doe joyfully and severally grant to warrant
and forever defend by these presents the above ſaid tract of land and p[er]missed —
with the appurtenances unto the ſaid Thomas Spynke his tenures and chynges
for ever In witness whereof the partye first above named have ſigned and affixed —
intertangably betwixt them and seal'd the day and year ſubſtantiall above
written.

due owing or of right belonging to me by or from the ſaid Edward Selby
and John Graham and upon non paymēt thereof the ſaid Edward Selby and
John Graham or either of them their or either of their Exectuē or Administratoē
for me and in my name to arreſt impriſon implead and proſecute for the ſame and
upon ſame ſuite to proceed to judgment and execution and ſt upon the ſaid
Edward Selby and John Graham their Exectuē or oldmē in prison to hold
and keep until payment therof be made with all reſte and damage suffiſſed
by occation therof or of the detaining of the ſame and upon paymēt thereof the ſaid
Edward Selby and John Graham their Exectuē and Adminſt of prison to a
diftarge and arquittance or other difcharged for me and in my name to make
ſtate and deliver and one or more attorney or attorneyes under him or them to
make conſtitute and appoint and att their wills and pleafure to rebate and alſo
to do þeir and exēcute all and every other lawfull and reaſonable act and
thing whatſoever both for the obtaining and difchargeing of the ſame as ſhall be
needfull to be done giving and by these presents granting unto my ſaid attorneyes my
full and absolute power in the þeir ratifying and holding ſame all and any
whatſoever my ſaid attorneyes ſhall lawfully do or cause to be done in or about
the execution of the þeir purpoſe by virtue of these presents In witness whereof
