

 paying therefore yearly every year unto & Thomas Gerard his Executors Administr-
 or Assignes three barrells of good Indian Shild Corne or thirty Shill in money &
 Short or three hundred pounds of good Aronico Tobacco & two Cypors forty days
 before or after & feast of St. blessed Saviours Nativity at & Mannet: Hours of St.
 Clements aforesaid & thers to appere upon Junions to do homage & service at all
 Courts Leetis & Courts barons if may or shall be holden upon & in Mannet: accord-
 =ing to & usuall Custome of England or & Law of this Province Provided, y^t
 & Shanker shall not sell or alienate & in peccell of Land but if he & John
 Shanker shall happen to Dy & leave no issue behinde him to survive that then
 after & decess of his now Wife Abigail or any other woman if he shall take
 to Wife then & whole peccell of Land shall retorne & redound to him the said
 Gerard his Heires Executors Administrators or Assignes for ever, any thing to &
 Contrary hereof before expressed notwithstanding & in Confirmation hereof
 the pties abovesaid have hereunto interchangedlie sett to there hands & seals
 the day & ycare first abovesaid written



 Acknowledge a Debt and satisfaction upon Record in the Provincial Court unto Thomas
 Catteron or his Attorney for all Judgments and Executions what so ever obtained in the abov-
 said Court, at my place, Whatsoever or at any time against the said Thomas Catteron, by
 Reason the said Thomas Catteron hath fully paid and satisfied the same, Ratifying allowing
 and confirming what so ever my said Attorney shall do or doe in the premises as if
 my self were personally present and had done the same, As Witness my hand and seal
 the third day of February Annoq Domini One thousand six hundred and Eighty

 Kintin Esq: gent One of the Attorneys of the Court, Acknowledged satisfaction
