January 17th 1680 Richard Atwoods of St Marys County desired that the mark of his Cart and Hogg might

Hogg might be recorded with us as followeth viz
a Hole in the right Card and a Set in the Left Card

This Indenture made the Eighteenth day of January in the seventh year of the Dominion
of Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Province of Maryland and Avalon Lord
Baron of Baltimore &c In the year of our Lord god One thousand six hundred and
Eighty Betweene Robert Wright of the County of Calvert
Clerke of the one part and Richard Smith Jun^r of the said County aforesaid
of the other part Whereas the Right Hon^{ble} Cecilio Lord Prop^r of the Province of
Maryland aforesaid by his Deed of Grants or Patents under his great Seal used in
the said Province of Maryland for granting of Land there Dated at St Marys
the Twelveth day of May in the four and thirtieth year of the said Dominion
One thousand Six hundred and Eighty did for the consideration therein Mentioned grants unto Ismael Wright two hundred
Acre of Land by the Name of Ismael Wright a parcel of Land called Wrights Piece
lying on the East side of Chesapeake Bay in Transquaking River in the Western
Branch of the said River, and on the West side of the said branch, Beginning at a
bounded Stake standing by the water side running Down the branch for breadth one
hundred twenty and five perches South with and by South to a Marked White oak
standing by a Marsh, running from the said Stake for length into the Woods two
hundred and forty perches, bounded on the North with a Line drawn North: east and by
North from the end of the former Line One hundred twenty five perches, bounded on the East
