

By This publick Instrument of Procuracion or Letter of Attorney Bee it knowne and manifest unto all those who shall see the same read That on the Thirtieth day of the month of August anno Domini One thousand & Sixtye and two hundred & thirtye-yeare of the Reigne of our Soveraigne Lord Charles the second by the Grace of God King of England Scotland France & Ireland Defender of the faith & Before me Nicholas Hayward Notary & Tabellion publick dwelling in London as by authority of his said Majestie admitted & Sworne And in the presence of him a witness hereafter named Personally appeared Mr George Gosfright of London Merchant (to me the said Notary well knowne) who staff made ordinari and Constituted as by his present in this hand & place the doff make ordaine a Constitute Thomas Taylor of Puttigay River in Maryland Merchant his friend & lawfull attorney giving and by his present granting unto his said attorney full power and lawfull authority for him Constituant and in his name and to his use to affre demand sue for lesy mante and retene of his friends debts or sumfys of late William Gongay of Puttigay River planter or merchant & destractes of any person or persons whome of right he doff or may concern all furt Robarre & goodes wares Merchandise or effects aduent due owinge belonging or appertaining unto the said George Gosfright his Constituant as well on accempt of goods confignyd unto the said late William Gongay as otherwise for what tyme or reason soever. And the said attorney is hereby empowred to retene into his possession all goodes whiche remaine in his hands and the products & proceeds of ffor disposed of, and to require a ffe feynt or accempt of all trade & dealeing betweene the Constituant and the said late William Gongay, and the said attorney to aduise & callane, offer to an empound further agree & determin any difference upon Robarre, and recypte to give discharge & dischargd in due forme, and if neede be to appear and the person of the said Constituant to represent in any Court or Courte & before all Lodes Judges & Justices there to answer demand & reply in all matter & cause touching or concerning her aymis to do say the impleadment & cōcōrt & quicke after attaint imprisoned to London & out of Prison againe to delivere. And generally to use all lawfull wayes & meanes for the recovery thereof either by course of law or otherwise as fully & amply to all intent & purpos as the Constituant himself might or could doe if personally present with power to substitue one or more attorneyes & the same againe to revoke the said Constituant promising to hold for him & valis all & whatsoevr the said attorney or his substitutes shall lawfully doe or cause to be done in & about the premises by vertue of this present In witness whereof the said Constituant hath hereunto putt his hand & seal the day & year first above written.
