 day of January in every repective year will & shal fully content satisfie and  
 pay unto the said James Ndale Junr and to her the said Ann Ndale after  
 the decease of the said James Ndale Junr during their life (if she survivre the  
 said James Ndale Junr) the sume of ffeve thousand pounds of good sound —  
 Incommutable Tobacco & Casse and sume barrels of good Indian Corn —  
 Upon the said Woolsthorpe Manors aforesaid In witness whereof the
