September 23: 1681: Richard Hartropp of St. Marys County desired that the markes of his hoggs & cattle might be returned which is as follows viz. A Cropp and a hole in one ear.

February 8: 1681: William Haurmont of St. Marys County desired that the markes of his hoggs and cattle might be returned which is as follows viz. A floure de Luce, an upper teeth and under teeth on both Eares.

February 24: 1681: Sarah Thompson of St. Marys County widow desired that the markes of her hoggs & cattle might be returned, being the markes of her husband (John Thompson late deceased) his hoggs and cattle, which is as follows, The Right Ear Cropp and Under teeth is a hole, the Left Ear Cropp, two shitts and take the piece square out.

made the twenty seaventh day of July in the fifth year of the Dominion of Charles Lord Baron of Baltimore Governor Maryland Annoq. Domi One thousand six hundred and Eighty Between Isaac Foxcroft of the Colony of Virginia Gentle and Bridgett his wife of the one part and Ninian Brack of Calvert County in the Province of Maryland Planter of the other part witnesseth that the said Isaac Foxcroft and Bridgett his wife for and in consideration of the sum of quantity of Twelve thousand pounds of tobacco to them in hand paid at and before the enrolling and delivery of this present Receipt wherof the said Isaac Foxcroft and Bridgett his wife heretofore acknowledged and the rest of and of every part and parcel wherof doth nearly acquitt execute and discharge the said Ninian Brack his heirs Executors Administrators and Assignes and every of them by this present have given granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by this present for themselves their heirs Executors Administrators Assignes doth nearly and absolutely give grant bargain sell alien enfeoffe and confirm unto the said Ninian Brack his heirs and Assignes for ever all that parcel of land called Mount pleasant situate lying and being in Calvert County on the West side of Patuxent River in the foot of the said River in the Northern branch beginning at a marked Oak standing by the River side and bounding on the South by a line drawn West three hundred and twenty paces to a marked Oak bounding on the West by a line drawn North and by East two hundred paces, bounded on the North by a line drawn East three hundred and twenty paces to a marked Pottery by the River side on the East by the said River to the first marked Oak containing by Estimation four hundred Acres of land, which said land was surveyed in John Potts his name deceased.
