 Debt due or sum of money aforesaid acquittance or other discharge for me and in my name
 to make sale and deliver, And all or every other Debt and Debt thing and thing devised or devised
 in the Law whatsoever in or out of the said or in or about the premises for the Recovery
 of all or any such Debt due and sum of money as aforesaid for me and in my name to the
 use aforesaid to do execute or perform as fully largely and simply in every respect to all intents
 Instructions or purposes as they shall think or could do if I were personally present satisfying
 knowing and conforming all or whatsoever my said Attorneys and either of them shall do
 or cause to be done in or about the Execution of the said by virtue of these presents In witness

Memorandum

that at a Provinciall Court held at the City of St. Marys the Twenty sixth day
 of May Anno Domini One thousand Six hundred Eighty and One before the Lopp Justice of the said Court
 John Abbingdon by Charles Botsler his Attorney and exhibited to the Court here a certain
 Transcript of the Record of Calvert County Court in a Cause here depending between Thomas
 and the said John Abbingdon in a plea of trespass of the Case In. T. of W. Record a
 followeth in his words Viz
 Charles absolute Lord & Prop. of the Province of Maryland & Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore or
 to the Justice of Calvert County greeting We command you to arrest John Abbingdon & him safely
 keep so that you have his body before our Justice of our next Calvert County Court to be held
 at Calvert Town the third Tuesday in June next here to answer unto Thomas Tennant of a
 plea of trespass upon the Case Next of you are not to fail. & have your true Writ given under the
 Seal of the said County the Seventeenth day of March One thousand six hundred Seventy Nine
