 length of Three hundred and Twenty perches into the woods to a marked pine thence running on
 a line South East and by South the breadth of Two hundred perches to a marked Oak standing
 by the River side near the Indian bridge, thence running Down the River side South South west
 Three hundred and Twenty perches to the first boundary containing by estimation four
 hundred Acres of land more or less together with all Rents profits and appurtenances and all and
 singular the rights profits privileges and appurtenances to the said partell of land belonging
