 Province of Maryland and also Lord Baron of Baltimore &c And in the year of
 our Lord God One thousand six hundred Eighty and One Between Richard Sonnd of
 the City in Calvert County in the Province of Maryland Merchant and Elizabeth his now wife
 his Sister and nearest at law of Paul Hussey late of Baltimore County Planter deceased of his
 one part and Richard Gwin of Charles County Planter and James Kyle of Cal-
 vert County aforesaid Coop^r of the other part witnesseth that whereas the
 Right Honorable Charles of most noble memory late absolute Lord and Prop^{ty} of the
 Province of Maryland and also Lord Baron of Baltimore by his Deed of grant or Patent under his great
 Seal issued in the said Province of Maryland for granting of lands there bearing date at
 the City of St. Marys the Twenty Ninth day of June in the year of our Lord God One
 thousand six hundred Sixty and three Did for the Consideration herein mentioned a
 grant unto Paul Hussey by the name of Paul Hussey of the said Province of Maryland
 a parcell of land called Pauls Neck lying in Chesapeake Bay and in a place a
 called Patapsco on the South side of the same River beginning at a marked Red oak standing
 on a point by a Creek and running up along the said River North west and by West four
 hundred One hundred paces to a marked white Oak standing on a point by a Creek
 called Deep Creek by a line drawn from the said Oak running South west along the
 said Creek for eighteene hundred and twenty paces by a line drawn from
 the said South west line running South east and by East One hundred paces by a line drawn
 from the said South east and by east by a line running North east into the first bound^d Red oak
 Creek hundred and twenty paces containing and layd out for Two hundred acres more or
 less &c after w^t all rights profits and benefits hereto belonging (royall Milles or
 acre^s) To have and to hold the same unto him the said Paul Hussey his heirs and
 assigns for ever to be held of his Lord^s and his Heirs as of his Lord^s Mann^e of
 Baltimore in free and common socage by fealty only for all manner of services under such
 rents, Covenants, Conditions, Limitacions and Exteyns as in and by the said writing did
 of grant or Patent relation bring hereto had if less and may more at large appear.
 And whereas the said Paul Hussey being then of tender age in estate without a Will and
 left behind him One son, who dyed an Infant, by reason whereof the said parcell of
 land amongst other things taint and devide into the said Elizabeth his now wife of
 the said Richard Sonnd as heire at law to her said Brother Paul Hussey deceased Now
 this Indenture further witnesseth, That they the said Richard Sonnd and Elizabeth his said
 wife
