Adm. or Assignee to which payment well and truly to be made and done I bind my self my heirs Esq. Adm. firmly by these presents sealed with my seal dated the first of February the day of March Anno Domini 1681.

The condition of these presents above written obligation is such that if the above bounden Richard Jones his heirs Esq. Adm. every of them shall do or from time to time and at all times forever hereafter well & truly observe performe fullfill and keep all and singular the covenants grants articles clauses and agreements mentioned contained expressed in one certain Indenture of bargain and sale or settlement bearing date with this present above written obligation made and made by and between the above bounden Richard Jones & Elizabeth his wife of the one part and the above said Richard Gwynn and James Kyle of the other part, which on the part and behalf of the said Richard Jones and Elizabeth his wife their heirs Esq. Adm. are and ought to be observed performed fullfill and kept, and that in and by all things according to the true intent and meaning of the said written Indenture respectively in all points contained that then this present above written obligation shall be void of none effect otherwise to stand & remaine in full force & virtue.
