

This Indenture made the third day of March in the eighth year of the Dominion of the  
 Right Hon<sup>e</sup>ble Charles Abolute Lord & Prop<sup>r</sup> of the provinces of Maryland & Avalon  
 Lord Baron of Baltimore &c In the Year of Our Lord God One thousand six hundred eighty three  
 Betweene John Baker of the City of St Maries in the province of Maryland Innholder of the One  
 part And Thomas Bayle of St Maries County in the Said province of Maryland Planter, Elizabeth  
 his now wife the Daughter of Elizabeth Baker now wife of the Said John Baker of the other party witnesseth  
 That whereas William Guyther of St Maries County in the Province of Maryland By his certaine writing  
 or Dode of bargaine & sale under his hand & seal bearing date the tenth Day of Aprill in the second  
 Year of the Dominion of Charles absolute Lord & Prop<sup>r</sup> of the provinces of Maryland & Avalon Lord Baron  
 of Baltimore anno Dom<sup>i</sup> One thousand six hundred seaventy seven and made between William  
 Guyther of St Maries County in the province of Maryland on the one part And Robert Mason of the  
 same County & province of the other part hath for the Consideration therin mentioned given granted  
 alidone bargained sold enfooffed & Confirmed And by these presents Did fully clearly & absolutely  
 give grant bargaine alion sell enfooff & confirme unto him the said Robert Mason his heires & assignes  
 for ever All that parcell or tract of Land commonly called or knowne by the name of Broad Neck in  
 St Maries hundred in the County aforesaid being bounded as follows Beginning upon a point of the  
 West side of the Beaver Swamps from a marked Hickory & running up the maine branch of the said  
 Swamps unto the outward line of the Said William Guythers And running North along the mid  
 Outward line to the head of the maine branch of the muddy pond and downe the said branch of  
 the muddy pond unto a marked Red Oak & running by the muddy pond from the marked red  
 Oak to the first mentioned tree a marked Hickory with every part or parcell of land that lies  
 betwixt the line of Mr Thomas Griffin And the line of Mrs Elizabeth Vorst Containing & then  
 laid Out for two hundred acres more or less Together with all & singular the rights & benefites  
 thereunto belonging or in any wise concerning the premises or any part or parcell of them with  
 all houses edifices buildings Orchards & gardens whatsoever thereunto belonging with all & singular  
 the rights members Jurisdiccons priviledges profits or benefites apperteyning or belonging therunto  
 To have and to hold the said tract or parcell of land and all & singular the bargained premises unto him  
 the said Robert Mason his heires & assignes for ever As in & by the said sealed writing or Dode of  
 bargaine & sale Relation being therunto had more all large it doth & may appear And whereas  
 also the said Robert Mason by his Certaine Indenture of Bargaine & sale under his hand & seal  
 bearing date the thirteenth day of March in the fifth year of the Dominion of the right Hon<sup>e</sup>ble  
 Charles Abolute Lord & Prop<sup>r</sup> of the provinces of Maryland & Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore  
 In the year of Our Lord God One thousand six hundred eighty three Made betwixt Robert Mason  
 of St Maries County in the province of Maryland Merchant of the One part & John Baker of the  
 City of St Maries in the said province of Maryland Innholder of the other part for the Consideration  
 therin mentioned Hath given granted alidone bargained sold enfooffed & confirmed And by these  
 presents Did fully clearly & absolutely give grant alion Bargaine sell enfooff & confirme unto  
 the said John Baker his heires & assignes all that the above mentioned parcell or tract of Land commonly  
 called or knowne by the name of Broad Neck lying in St Maries hundred in the County aforesaid  
 bounding as aforesaid & Conteyning & laid Out for two hundred acres of land bee the same more  
 or less Together with all Messuages Tenements Dwelling houses Yards Barnes Stables Outhouses  
 Edifices buildings tobaccohouses backides gardens & Orchards with their poyery of their appurtenances  
 withall Rights members, profits, priviledges, Jurisdiccons, & Benefites to the same belonging,  
 or in any wise apperteyning, And all timber, & timber trees, rues, passages, woods, underwoods,  
 fences, rents, easments, Commodities hereditments & appurtenances whatsoever to the said  
 parcell or tract of Land Messuages Tenements Dwelling houses yards gardens & Orchards belonging  
 or in any wise apperteyning or accepted reputed taken demised or occupied or enjoyed  
 as part parcell or member thereof And the Reversion & Reversions Remayndore remainders  
 issues & profits whatsoever of all & singular the before mentioned to be here by bargained  
 premises with their poyery of their appurtenances and every part of parcell therof And all
