

This Indenture made the fifteenths day of October in the year of Our Lord one thousand six hundred eighty & two between William Holmes of St. Maries County in the province of Maryland Planter & Frances his wife & Robert Carville of St. Maries County Gent of the one part & John Baker of St. Maries County Inholder of the other part witnesseth that whereas William Lucas in his life time late husband to Frances now wife to the said William Holmes had agreed to sell & convey unto Henry Ryder a parcel of land lying & being upon St. Charles Crooke in St. James in the said County Bounded upon the Crooke side A depth by a marked Oak & south by a marked pickhickey being part of the land whereon the said William Lucas then lived & by him laid out & bounded in his life time But before a conveyance of the said land was executed he the said Lucas dyed having made his last will Testament in writing & the said Frances sole Executrix & by the said will he did amongst other things empower his said Executrix to Confirm the sale of the said land which he had sold to the said Ryder he paying the tobacco for the same as by the said will bearing date the Thirteenth day of November Anno Dom 1675 may appear in pursuance of which said will the said Frances in Consideration of the sume of seaven thousand pounds of tobacco being the sume agreed between the said Lucas & the said Ryder to be paid for the purchasing the said land to her wch & truly paid by the said Ryder did by her Indenture bearing date the fifth day of November Anno Dom 1677 freely & absolutely give Bargaine & sell & Confirm unto the said Ryder & his heires for ever the said parcel of land with the appurtenances therunto belonging & the said Henry Ryder did upon the same day by his writing under his hand & seal Indorsed on the same Indenture sell Assign & sell over for the like Consideration unto the said Robert Carville the said Indenture to him the said Robert Carville his heires & assignes for ever but before the said Indenture & Assignment aforesaid were acknowledged to be Recorded according to law he the said Henry Ryder departed his province And whereas the said William Holmes & Frances his wife for the better & more sure settling & estabishing the said parcel of land unto the said Robert Carville & his heires for ever according to the said Assignment from the said Ryder & the deed made to the said Ryder from the said Frances pursuant to the will of the said Lucas made by their Indenture bearing date the tenth day of July One thousand six hundred eighty & one for the Consideration therin mentioned Bargaine sell release & Confirm unto the said Robert Carville & his heires for ever the before mentioned parcel of land AND WHEREAS the said Robert Carville for & in Consideration of the sume of eight Thousand pounds of tobacco sound merchantable Loaf tobacco in Canke to be paid by the said William Holmes his heires Executors or Administrators to the said Robert Carville his Executors Administrators or assignes in manner following viz: Two thousand pounds of tobacco upon the first day of January which should be in the year of Our Lord One thousand six hundred eighty & two William Holmes & his heires for ever all that the before mentioned parcel of land lying & being upon St. Charles Crooke in St. James bounding on the Crooke side north by a marked Oak & south by a marked pickhickey being part of the said Lucas his land whereon he dwelt & by him laid out & bounded in his lifetime with all proffitts & appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging to have and to hold the said parcel of land before by these presents mentioned to be granted bargained & sold to him the said William Holmes his heires & assignes for ever free & clear & absolutely acquitted & discharged of all manner of former & other bargaines sales gifts grants Judgments, tithes, troubles, & Incumbrances whatsoever done by the said Robert Carville or any claiming by from or under him & the said Robert Carville for himself his heires Executors Administrators or any person or persons giveng or agreeing to & with the said William Holmes his heires Executors Administrators That he the said William Holmes his heires & assignes should & might from time to time & at all times thowafter peaceably & quietly hold & enjoy the said land & premises without the least suit or Interruption of him the said Robert Carville or any other person or persons claiming by from
