This Indenture made this fifteenth day of February in the eighth year of the Dominion of the Right Honble Charles absolute Lord & proprie of the province of Maryland Lord Baron of Baltimore in the year of Our Lord God One thousand six hundred & eighty two between William Smyth of Calvert County in the province of Maryland of the one partie: & Henry Mitchell of the same County in the province aforesaid on the other partie. Witnesseth that the said W<sup>m</sup> Smyth for & in consideration of the summe of twenty pounds Sterling monoy to him in hand paid by the said Henry Mitchell before the sealing & delivery hereof wherof & wherewithal the said W<sup>m</sup> Smyth doth acknowledge himself to be fully & wholly satisfied & doth of his for every part & parcel hereof acquitt & discharge y<sup>e</sup> said Henry Mitchell his heires executors & assignes by these presents hath given granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed & confirmed & by these presents doth fully & absolutely give grant bargeine & sell enfeoffed & confirmed to the said Henry Mitchell his heires & assignes all that parcell of land called Gunslie being in Calvert County lying upon the Bluff beginning at the west side Chesapeake bay at a marked pochickong tree being a bounded tree of the land of William Madowell & running up the bay by a line drawn north & west for length one hundred porches to a bounded popular by the land of John Newell To have and to hold the said parcell of land with all & singular appurtenances therunto belonging to the said Henry Mitchell his heires executors & assignes for ever to the only use & behoofe of the said Henry Mitchell his heires & assignes for ever the said William Smyth for himself his heires executors & administrators doth hereby Covenant & grant to & with the said Henry Mitchell his heires & assignes & every of them by those presents In manner forme following that is to say that he the said William Smyth all the time of the sealing & delivery hereof is fully seized of the promises & hath good & lawfull power & authority in his owne Right to grant Convey & assure the said promises every part & parcel hereof unto the said Henry Mitchell his heires & assignes in manner & forme aforesaid & also the said Henry Mitchell his heires & assignes & every of them shall & may at all times during the Estate hereby made & passed quietly & peaceably have hold use & enjoy all & singular the said granted promises with the appurtenances according to the true meaning hereof without any fettle trouble or Charge whatsoever of or by the said W<sup>m</sup> Smyth his heires or assignes or any of them having or claiming to have any Right or title therunto & the said W<sup>m</sup> Smyth doth further Covenant & grant for himself his heires executors & with the said Henry Mitchell his heires & assignes & every of them at the reasonable request Cost & Chargos in the law of the said Henry Mitchell his heires & assignes to make acknowledge Executed & Suffer cause to be made acknowledged Executed & suffered all & every such further & other lawfull & reasonable act & acts assurance & assurances in the law whatsoever for the further & better assurance hereby making & Convoighing of the said Granted promises with the appurtenances or any part thereof unto him the said Henry Mitchell his heires & assignes according to the true meaning hereof or as by the said Henry Mitchell his heires & assignes or his or their Councill learned in the law in that behalfe shall be reasonable devised
