agreed due it is hereby voluntarie granted and agreed by and betwixt

appurtenances to the sole and only proper use and behoofe of the said Charles
Lord Baltimore and of his heires and assigned for ever due to and for now
ever by intent or purpose whatsoeuer in virtute whereof all the said
parties to these presents have to day part of these presents put their hand
