Mieglaid Swall Esq. hath remised released and quite rayned sold and quitte layned unto his said Nicholas Swall and susanna his swall all and every his Right title interest property possession rayned demanded which shal the said Ladye Dame Baltimore have or dole rayned of and in and unto the said two thousand acres of land called the manor of Charles guest by vertue of the said recited Lord patentes or by any title endando or wayed what soever soe that the said Ladye Dame Baltimore of and from his said manor and lands and his appurtenances to be said manor and lands belonging and of and from all Right title possession in todest estate either for life or otherwise and all other raynado and demandado of in and to the same is and shall be utterly debarred and for ever excludado by these presents In witness whereof the said Ladye Dame Baltimore hath hereunto put her hand and sealed the seacon of twenty fifth day of April in the year of the Dominion of the said Charles Lord and proprie of the said province of Maryland he.
