

To all persons to whom these presents shall come greeting Know yee
that Richard Broughton of Charles County in the province of Maryland
gentlemane good tauld and Consideration whereunto touching Hauers
givin granted bargained solde and delivered and by these presynt
doe give grant bargained solde and delivered from me my heire
executors admittors and assignees for ever All that partale of land called
Nangemys lying situating and boun in Baltimore County in the province
of Maryland betwene the falls of Gun powder River in the wood beginning
at a bounded oare and running west one hundred and fifty perches to
a bounded oare then southe fourt hundred perches to the maine fall of her
East w^t the said fall one hundred and fifty perches then North to the
first bound tree contayning and now layd out for three hundred and
soadinty fiftie acres of land botys same now or lesse and also all that
partale of land called Broughtons forest lying situating and boun in
the said province of Maryland in Baltimore County on the head
of the back River of Gun powder River beginning at a marked white
oare and running southe East sixty perches to a bounded Spanish
oare standing by the maine runn of the said River commonly called
by the name of the Herring runn then bouning on the said Runn
lying by southe west and by southe thirtie perches to a marked
lotust tree still bouning on the said Runn lying by southe west for
length of fiftie hundred perches then North North west three
hundred perches then by a straight line to the first bound tree
contayning and now layd out for fiftie hundred and soadinty five
acres of land botys whiche tractes of land aforesaid in the whole
amount unto the fall and just quantity of Nine hundred
and fiftie acres of land botys same now or lesse unto George Thompson
of St. Marido County in the province of Maryland hant to him his
heires executors admittors and assignees for ever together with all Right
proffits and benefites to the said partale or tractes of land belonging
or in any maner of wayes apperteyning (Royall munde excepted) Yelding
and paying therfore yearly unto the Right hono^{rable} Lord Baron of Baltimore
Lord and proprie of the plantation of Maryland and his heires at the rate
rate of a shillinge off St. Marido and at the two most small feaste in the
yeare next at the feaste of the assumption of the blessed virgin Mary
and at the feaste of St. Michael the Archangel by even and equall portions
the roent of one pound eight shillings sterling in silver or gold being
the full and yearly roent of the whole nine hundred and fifty acres of
land as aforesaid to have and to hold the aforesaid partale of land
contayning and layd out for Nine hundred and fifty acres of land ad
aforesaid together with all the Rightes Jurisdiction and appurtenance
what soever therunto belonging or in any maner of wayes apperteyning
to the said George Thompson his heires executors admittors and assignees
paying for a fine upon every alienation of the said land or any part or pte
thereof one whole yeare roent in silver or gold or the full value thereof of as
the said Lord Baron of Baltimore or his heires or such officer or officers
appointed by him or his heires to collect or receive the same shall accept in
discharge thereof And if the said Richard Broughton doth hereby oblige buy
also my heires executors admittors and assignees for ever do warrant
and defend the said heire against all manner of laynes or claynes by
any maner of person or persons what soever unto the said George
