This Indenture made the sixth day of December anno Domini one thousand six hundred eighty four Between John Evans of Calvert County in the Province of Maryland Carpenter of the one part and Thomas Smith of the County and Province of aforesaid Carpenter of the other part Whereas Robert Wright of the said County Planter by Letter Patent under the great Seal of the said Province bearing date the fourteenth day of April in the five and Thirtieth year of the Dominion of the R. G. GRANWELL the then Lord Proprietary anno Domini 1664 had granted unto him a parcel of Land for One hundred and fifty acres called Long Rights Sessuate Butte and Bounded as in the said patent is Express'd all whose Right title and Interest of in and to the said Land he the said Robert Wright by a certaine Conveyance or writing under his hand and seal and duly Entred upon Record in the Provinciall Court of the said Province Disigned and made over unto the said John Evans his heirs and Assignors for ever as by the said Patent and Conveyance Relation being thereunto had may more at Large appear Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said John Evans for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand pounds of tobacco to him paid or secured to be paid the Receipt whereof and from the said Thomas Smith doth hereby acknowledge and thereof land from every part thereof doth acquit the said Thomas Smith for ever by these presents hath granted Bargained and Sold unto the said present doth freely and absolutely Grant Bargaine and Sale unto him the said Thomas Smith his heirs and assignors for ever all that aforementioned Tract of One hundred and fifty acres of Land called Long Rights with all and Singular the Rights members and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining together with all other Evidence or writings any way touching or concerning the same or any part or parcel thereof To Have & to Hold the said One hundred and fifty acres of Land and all other appurtenances to him the said Thomas Smith His heirs and Assignors for ever And the said John Evans for himself his heirs Executors Administrators doth hereby Covenant and grant to and with the said Thomas Smith his executors Administrators and Assignors to warrant and defend the said Bargained promises of and from all Claimers whatsoever And the said John Evans his Heirs Executors Administrators will make performe and execute from time to time such further and other acts Deed Writing and Conveyance or agreeance in the Law for the further Convenging and assuring the said Land unto the said Thomas Smith his heirs and Assignors as the Law shall Requier and as by that he the said John Evans hath good Right and full power at the Sealing hereof to sell and dispose of the said premises to him the said Thomas Smith his heirs and assignors as aforesaid In witness whereof the said John Evans hath to his present Indenture of Bargaine and Sale set his hand and seal the day and year first above written
