 Grant and Confirm to my Daughter Hester A Brindle Cow called Young good luck being marked with a  
 Poppe on both Ears and p<sup>r</sup>esked on both Ears and a hole in the Right Ear being the proper marks of  
 the said Daniel Devine and one Black Heifer of the same marke called Blackwell about three  
 years old and one breeding Sow of the same marke together with all their Increase from hence forth  
 falling growing and Renewing to have and to hold the same to her the said Hester her Executors Administrators  
 and assigns to her and their own proper use for ever Alse I do hereby Give grant and Confirm  
 to my Daughter Mary one Red Sow called Cherry about four years old and of the same marke and one  
 Black Heifer of the same marke and about the same age and one breeding Sow of the same marke  
 together with all their Increase from hence forth falling growing and Renewing to have and to hold  
 the same to her the said Mary her Executors Administrators and assigns to her and their own proper use  
 for ever Likewise I do hereby give and Grant to my Daughter Martha a pydye parlyng light for  
 of the same marke together with all her Increase from hence forth falling growing and Renewing  
 to have and to hold the same to her the said Martha her Executors Administrators and assigns to her  
 their own proper use for ever And I the said Ann Devine all and singular the said several Coven-  
 ant and promises aforesaid to the said Hester Mary & Martha their Executors Administrators and assigns to the use  
 aforesaid in manner and forme aforesaid against all people do warrant and for ever defend by these  
 presents Provided always and it is the true Intent and meaning of me the said Ann Devine with  
 promise that if it should please god that any of my said Daughters should happen to dye before  
 they should come to the age of one and twenty year or be Married that then the part hereby given  
 of such Daughter so dying and their Increase to be and Remain to the survivor of them their  
 Executors Administrators and assigns for ever In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
 and Seale this seventeenth day of June in this year of our Lord One Thousand six hundred eighty  
 four

 in the Province of Maryland Gent send Greeting in our Lord god everlasting Know ye that I the said  
 James Bowling for and in Consideration of the Real Love goodwill and great affection that I bear  
 unto my dear and Loving wife Mary Bowling Do by these presents freely and absolutely give grant  
 alienat Transferr Sellover and deliver unto the Hon<sup>ble</sup> C<sup>o</sup> Henry Darnall Justice for my said wife  
 four Slaves to wit Ann a Malatta Sara a Negroa and Elizabeth a Negroa all female together  
 with a male Negro named George all Children to a Negroe woman called Mary to have and to hold  
 the said four Slaves with their Increase unto the said Henry Darnall his Executors Administrators  
 and assigns for the use of my said wife as her own proper estate with warranty of the said four Slaves  
 unto the said Henry Darnall his Executors Administrators and assigns for the use aforesaid against my self my heirs  
 and assigns and against all other persons whatsoever that shall or may lawfully claim the said Slaves  
 or any of their Increase hereafter In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Affix  
 my Seale this fifth day of September in this Year of the Dominion of the R<sup>o</sup> Hen<sup>o</sup> Charles the  
 Anno d<sup>o</sup> Dom<sup>o</sup> 1684
