

# This Indenture

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Witness Between Elizabeth Calvert of St. Mary's County the Relict Admire of the late Hono<sup>rable</sup>  
 William Calvert Esq<sup>r</sup> deceased and now Guardian to Charles Calvert Gent of the one parte and  
 Hugh Manning of the same County Planter of the other part witnesseth that his said Elizabeth  
 Calvert for and in Consideration of a certane Grant or Sale mad<sup>e</sup> to her by the said Hugh Manning  
 of one hundred acres of Land called neck to her sealed and delivered before  
 his unsealing of these presents and bearing date herewith as also for divers other valuable  
 Considerationes to her in hand paid before the sealing hereof doth hereby Grant Bargain  
 and sell Almyg<sup>t</sup> and sett over unto the said Hugh Manning all that tract or piece of Land  
 lying in St. Mary's County in a place called the Lower End of the Towne on a Creek called Smith-  
 Creek and on Potomak River Beginning at a marked Oak standing on the South side of a great  
 path near Marks Bloomfield Running thence West forty perches to a bounded Oak of Marks  
 Bloomfield bounding upon the said Land East and by North One hundred & Ninety perches to  
 the first bounded tree of Marks Bloomfield standing by a brooke side running with thence eight  
 perches thence bounding with the Creek Southwest and by South Twenty eight perches Southeast  
 and by South Twenty four perches South Southwest thirty perches Southwest and by South Sixty perches  
 South Southeast forty two perches East and by South One hundred and Thirty perches to a marked  
 oak by a brooke side thence North Northwest three degrees East by One hundred Eighty Six  
 perches to the first Bounded tree Containing Two hundred acres of Land more or less  
 together with all Rights profits benefits and priviledges therunto belonging Royall Min  
 excepted to have and to hold the said Two hundred acres of Land unto the said Hugh Manning  
 his Heires and Assignes for ever to be held of St. Michaels Manor yielding and paying  
 therefor yearly unto the said Elizabeth Calvert his Heire or Assigne One Cupp of  
 fall Capons or Hens at or on the tenth day of October yearly and every year thereafter  
 the said Elizabeth Calvert for herself her Heires and Assignes doth hereby Covenant  
 and Grant that at the sealing hereof she hath in herself good Right full power and  
 Authority to Grant Bargain and sell the same unto the said Hugh Manning his Heire  
 and Assigne the aforesaid tract or piece of Land aforesaid and further shall warrant and  
 defend the same title to be good and Indefearable in the Law and further shall warrant  
 and defend the same of and from herself her Heire and Assigne and off and from all  
 and every other person or persons whatsoever and lastly the said Elizabeth Calvert for herself  
 her Heire and Assigne doth Covenant promise and Grant by these presents to and  
 with the said Hugh Manning his Heire and Assigne that if it shall happen that any  
 disturbance shall or may at any time arise of or concerning that part of Land belonging  
 to Robert Smith or Marks Bloomfield that thereby any part may be taken out of the aforesaid  
 tract then the said Eliz. Calvert doth hereby promise and oblige Herself her Heire  
 that she or they shall and will allow and make good the same from the above said North  
 northwest bounded tree In witness whereof the said Elizabeth Calvert hath  
 herein set her hand and sealed the day and year aforesaid
