five shillings and three pence for his Lordships third part thereof, and to the said N. French
Blackiston for the use of himself and the said Samuel Cooper who a swill as by the
sum of fifteen pounds five shillings and three pence & fiftieth of the said sum of
forty five pounds fifteen shillings and three pence for their third part thereof in full
satisfaction of Ropps and goods appraised as aforesaid Now know ye that we the
said William Shreve for and on the part and behalf of our said Sovereign Lord
the King, Henry Darwall for and on the part and behalf of the said Lord Prop. of the
Governor as aforesaid and the said N. French Blackiston for himself and Samuel
Cooper do by these presents for and in consideration of the premises discharge
the said ship Glory of Leidenerry, and all her guns Tackl, ammunition furniture
apparel and the goods aforesaid from the arrest therein, action, Judgment; and
judicature aforesaid and the said ship with all her guns Tackl ammunition
furniture and apparel and the goods aforesaid Do fully clearly & absolutely
grant to the said Nathaniel Davis the Master aforesaid In testimony whereof we
