 the said Nathaniel Davis hath paid unto the said William Shivers for the use of his Majesty
 for his third part of the said forty five pounds five shillings and five pence, the
 sum of fifteen pounds five shillings, and five pence, and to the said Henry Darnall
 for the use of the Lord Prop^r of this Governour aforesaid the like sum of fifteen pounds,
 five shillings and five pence for his Lordships third part thereof, and to the said Nathaniel
 Blackiston for the use of himselfe and the said Samuel Cooper who are well known by the
 sum of fifteen pounds five shillings & five pence of the said sum of
 forty five pounds five shillings and five pence for their third part thereof in full
 satisfaction of the said goods appraised as aforesaid Now know ye that the
 said William Shivers for and on the part and behalfe of our said Sovereign Lord
 the King, Henry Darnall for and on the part and behalfe of the said Lord Prop^r of this
 Governour as aforesaid and the said Nathaniel Blackiston for himselfe and Samuel
 Cooper Doe by these presents for and in satisfaction of the principal & discharge
 the said ship of Londonerry, and all her guns tackle, ammunition furniture
 appurtenances and the goods aforesaid from the arrest herein, accou, Judgment, and
 satisfaction aforesaid and the said ship with all her guns tackle ammunition
 furniture and appurtenances and the goods aforesaid Doe fully & absolutely
 grant to the said Nathaniel Davis the Master aforesaid In Testimony whereof we
