When upon the said Nicholas Blackflov: and Samuel Cooper as well for the said Lord the King and the said Lord Prop:ty as for the use of the said Lord the King the said John Woodfild Master or Comander of the said Ship or V:sh:ll with all the goods Ball:st: the Rob:rt of Laru: may forfeit the said Ship or V:sh:ll with all the goods Ball:st: ammunicon furniture and Apparell and all the said goods and Commodities before mentioned according to the form of the Statute aforesaid and that the same forfeiture may be divided into three equal parts, Our third part thereof to our Sovereign Lord the King, Our third part to the said Lord Prop:ty the said Governour as aforesaid and the other third part thereof to the said Nicholas Blackflov: and Samuel Cooper according to the form of the said Statute; and that the said John Woodfild may come into Court to answer our said Sovereign Lord the King, the said Lord Prop:ty the said Governour as aforesaid and the said Nicholas Blackflov: and Samuel Cooper who as well for the said Lord the King the said Lord Prop:ty as for the use of the said Lord the King in the behalfs profess: of and upon the said Statute.

And the said John Woodfild Master of the said Ship aforesaid by Nicholas Blackflov: his Attorney Com: and defend: the force and injury which he did say the said is not guilty of the breach of the Statute aforesaid in manner and form as above expressed upon him and that his defence may be Enquir'd of by the Country and the Plaintiffs also.
