& thence running into the Woods with A Line drawn South West & by South

South West till it intersect the North line of the land late of Cap^t William Hawley
now in the possession of Mr the said William Guythor thence bounding with the said North
line for the length of One hundred & sixty Perches till it meet with A Branch from
the Bay Side going on the North Side of Popps Hogge Ponn neck & thence running
ad the said Branch runneth into the said Bay & so bounding with the said Bay
to the first bound tree containing by Estimation One hundred & Ninety Acres of Land
