To the Hon^o E^t Henry Darvall and the Hon^o E^t William Digges Com^{rs} of the Gov^{rn}ment and also to N^o. N^o. Blackston, Com^r of the Customs in the Province of Maryland

Whereas at a Provincial Court held at the City of St. Marye the eight day of March in the fifth year of the Dominion of Charles Lord Baltimore Esq^r Anno Dⁿⁱ 1684 the Ship Robert of Larn^o in Ireland was informed against trye and good ware and whereas the Court Ord^rd (by Counsel of N^o. N^o. Blackston and Samuel Cooper) that Capt. John Osbourne, M^r. James Dashiell, M^r. Richard Whitey and M^r. John King should be appointed to view appraise and value the said Ship Ammunition guns tackle and appertain to the said Shipp belonging, and goods ware and in the Informations on or before the last day of March.

These are therefore humbly to Certifie that the said persons so appointed app^r and b^e for us and took the oath of an Appraiser and on the Nineteenth day of March did appraise the said Shipp with her tackle furniture and appertain Ammunition and guns to our hundred and fifty pounds sterling, and as for the goods ware and in the Informations was by Capt. John Osbourne M^r. John King and M^r. Richard Whitey appraised to Eleven pounds and our shilling, eight pence sterling which appraisment was returned the Twenty eighth day of March last past All which I do Certifie under my hand and Seal the second day of April Anno Dⁿⁱ 1685.

Whereas it was Ord^rd that we the Subscribers should take an account in writing of the wages due to each Seaman in or belonging to the Ship Robert of Larn^o and to report and send the same together and a long with the appraisment of the said Ship and goods to the Hon^o E^t Henry Darvall, the Hon^o E^t William Digges and M^r. N^o. N^o. Blackston or either of them, which Report we have taken from the Master of the said Ship (not having opportunity to take an account of each particular Seaman) who hath given an account of our hundred forty eight pounds, our shilling and which said account was transmitted to the Hon^o E^t Darvall, E^t William Digges and M^r. N^o. N^o. Blackston: April the 2^d Anno Dⁿⁱ 1685.
