The Court being called the Cause was demanded the Cause (by virtue of which said) to be heard
 by the Court vizt. Thomas Gouard by the said Court appointed which was accordingly done
 and followed in the following words vizt.

Charles absolute Lord and Proprietor of the Province of Maryland and Avalon Lord
 Baron of Baltimore &c. to James Pattison and Garratt Vanvorringon Gentlemen Justices
 Whereas we are informed that there are and may be several shippes now in this Province and
 in probability may come in thereafter that have been transgressed the Majesty's Acts of a
 Parliament that the same are and may be liable to informations for the same and for that there
 came to nothing more advantageous to the trade of this Province than to make a quiet
 dispatch of the proceedings of Maritime affairs where by they may not be long in suspension and
 put the parties into unnecessary charge by dilatory proceedings and being very well assured
 of your Judgment's ability, honesty, and understanding in such like affairs have appointed
 empowered constituted and ordained you the said James Pattison and Garratt Vanvorringon to be
 Judges of a Speciall Court of Oyer and Terminer for the tryall conviction or acquittal
 of such shippes or shippes vishill or vishill as you shall be informed of and made known to be
 culpable in transgressing against the Majesty's laws of navigation and other laws that
 relate to the Majesty's Customs together with the waggons tackle furniture, ammunition, apperrell
 and goods and merchandise which shall be imported contrary to the said laws, And also to
 call
