there stay for some days and after that day and upon the first day of February in  
the year 1684: aforesaid came to anchor in the port of St. Marys in St. Marys  
County in the said Province of Maryland within the Jurisdiction of this Court and  
there and there riding at anchor and well knowing the said Statute to be in full  
force and in practice but the said Statute notwithstanding the said penalties  
and forfeitures in the said Statute any way regarding them and their  
imports and brought into the said Province of Maryland in the said Shipp or  
V. s. l. divers and sundry goods and merchandise of the growth production and  
manufacture of Europe which was not really and bona fide shipped laden or  
taken in in England Wales or the Towns of Barwick upon Tweed but were by  
the said John Elliot and Jasper Sykes shipped or laden or taken on board the  
said Shipp or V. s. l. in the Kingdom of Ireland that is to say Eighteen hogheads  
of Carrish Wyne, three barrels of salt, a Tun of brandy, One hundred and  
thirty two of brown linen, two boxes of Candles, fifty six pairs of French  
French falls, seven pairs of boyes, eleven pairs of women's shoes, nine dozen  
of Yarn stockings, eighty six quilts, four dozen of women's white ruffled hand  
kerchiefs dozen of handkerchiefs, five pounds of white brown thread, two gross  
and a half of hair comb buttons, two pounds of Colored thread, eight pairs  
of silk gowns, four pairs of mitts, fifteen pairs of Irish stockings, one  
of white Duvety, five rough shetes two parcels of curried leather, two pounds of  
colored thread Twenty pairs of coarse yam stockings, eighty two black ruffled hand  
kerchiefs, five pairs of brogues, forty two pairs of French falls, seven pairs of  
button pockets, two dozen of painted leather gloves, two gross of Colored thread  
buttons, three shewmakers knives, a hammer, a parcel of bristles, six iron  
nails, two remnants of Tapes, eight dozen of Colored thread, and four dozen  
of buttons, three fine suits, two yards and a half of fine, eighty yards of  
purple tawny, two yards half of black shalour, seven pairs of yam stockings  
Twenty five yards of Irish lining, two yards and half of purple tawny four  
pairs of French worsted stockings, twenty five felt hats, eighty three pairs of  
brogues, two felt hats, two parcels of fine, from N. A. to N. M. or  
containing one hundred and eighty yards, twenty eight yards of broad black  
flannel, twenty three yards and half of white broad flannel, fifty six  
dozen suits of hats and breeches, seven and boyes, two pairs of breeches, nine  
pairs of French falls, thirty pairs of women's shoes, they the said John Elliot  
and Jasper Sykes upon the said first day of February aforesaid had did out of the  
said ship or V. s. l. unload and putt a shore the several goods and merchandise  
therein before mentioned and other European wares aforesaid by them in the said  
imports they the said John Elliot and Jasper Sykes were guilty of the same not having

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
