 And that the same forfeiture may be divided into three equale partes: One third
 part thereof to be for the King: the said King One third part thereof to the said Lord
 properly the Governour: as is said of the Province: and the other third part thereof
 to be for the said forfeiture to him the said Nicholas Swall Collector: as is said
 according to the forme of the said Statute: and that the said John Esio and Jasper
 Lych may come into Court to answer our said foraign Lord the King, the said
 Lord properly the Governour: as is said and the said Nicholas Swall who asw. for
 the said Lord the King the said Governour: as for himselfe: in this behalf
 present: the of and upon the premises:

And upon this it is Comanded the Sheriff of St. Marys County that he give
 notice to the said John Esio and Jasper Lych Merchants: to appear at the
 said Court this day to be had the next day in the premises: as is said

At the said day to wit the second day of May Anno Domini 1635: came the
 said Jasper Lych Merchant into the Court in his proper person before the Justice
 of the said Court to answer the said Lord the King the said Governour: and the said
 Nicholas who asw. for of and upon the premises: but the said John Esio was not
 by the said Sheriff: to be found in his dayliabert:

And the said Jasper Lych Merchant in Court was asked by Robert Carvill an
 Attorney for the King what he had to say to the Information why the said Shipp and
 goods mentioned therein should not be condemned lost and forfeited according to the
 Act of Parliament in that case provided: Mr Lych thereupon moved the Court that the
 Tryall might be put off and deferred for the space of two or three dayes longer: the
 Court would not admitt of or consent unto: He also: saide that he himselfe could
 not tell how to plead to the Information and that he was wanting of Councill:
 he still imagining till this day last that Mr. Carvill was for him, Mr. Carvill
 answered he never retid any office of him nor ever was his Attorney, the said Mr. Lych
 further said that the goods in the Information mentioned be longed to several others
 in answer to wch Mr. Carvill alledged that he did not retid to do all in his owne
 name and although several others might be concerned he was the Chief and as it
 was the Case of the Merchant for the whole:

The Court adjourned till four a clock in the afternoon.

At the said time the Court sat again:
 The said Jasper Lych still insisted for longer time before Tryall, But it is ordered
 by the Court that the said Lych now sitte with the plea to the Information and come
 to tryall immediately.

And the said Jasper Lych in his owne proper person cometh and defendeth the force
 and
