

Lying on the North side of Potowmack river commonly called or known by the name of Maryland  
 Royall bounded as followeth - beginning at a marked oak the bound tree of John Gomphinsons land -  
 Standing neare a bluse royall of wood by the said river side called Maryland royall running Northwest  
 by the river side for the length of one hundred Twenty and eight perches to a marked oak standing  
 by the river side bounding on the North with a line drawn North East into the wood for the length  
 of four hundred perches to a marked oak on the east with a line drawn South East from the end  
 of the former line until you meete with the exterior line of Jno. Gomphinson land on the South with  
 the said land on the West with the said river Containing by estimation four hundred acres  
 more or less as in and by the same deed indentured & recorded in the Provinciall Courte of this -  
 province more at large appeareth by vertue of which grant of alligation aforesaid the s<sup>r</sup>. Jno. Atkins  
 became seized and possessed of the said land and tenement aforesaid in his demesne of fee and being  
 so thereof seized and possessed afterward that is to say the day of 168 the said John  
 Atkins did make his last will and testam. in writing and thorowly did give and devyse to his  
 said Rebeka then wife of the said John in these words (right) Item I give and bequeath unto my louing  
 wife Rebeka Atkins the one halfe of my personall estate after all my debts being paid and funeral  
 Chars being satisfied also doo give and bequeath unto my louing wife Rebeka Atkins toward  
 hundred acres of land lying and being in Charles County Neare unto Maryland royall to her and to  
 her heire to have and to hold for ever as by the s<sup>r</sup>. will & testam. may appear and wherale the said  
 John Atkins afterward dyed leaving the said land and promissed to his s<sup>r</sup>. Rebeka by will aforesaid  
 Now this Testamente further witnesseth that his s<sup>r</sup>. Rebeka Dayly for consideration of the sum of  
 Twelue thousand pounds of tobacco to her in hand paid by the said Gilbert Clark before the sealing and  
 Delivry of these presents the receipt whereof the said Rebeka Dayly doth hereby acknowledge and  
 thorow of every part and parcel thereof doth clearly and absolutely acquit & dischare  
 him the said Gilbert Clark his Execut<sup>t</sup>s and Adm<sup>t</sup>s by these presents and for dind<sup>t</sup> other good cause  
 And Halluable Consideration thereunto moving have given granted alledged bargained and  
 sold & by these presents doo give grant allien bargained sold Entred & confirmed unto his s<sup>r</sup>. Gilbert  
 Clark his heire and assignes for ever all that before recited has parcell or deuident Lying on the North  
 Side beginning at a marked oak & bound tree Jno. Gomphinsons land standing neare a bluse royall of  
 Wood by the said river side called Maryland royall running Northwest by the river side for the length  
 of one hundred Twenty & eight perches to a marked oak standing by the river side bounding on the North  
 with a line drawn North East into the wood for the length of four hundred perches to a marked oak  
 On the east with a line drawn South East from the end of the former line until you meet with the exterior  
 line of Jno. Gomphinson land on the South with his land on the West with the said river Containing by  
 estimation four hundred acres more or less with all and sundry the land tenement rights Members  
 or appurtenances to the same or any part or parcel thereof belonging or appertaining together with all  
 Deeds Evidences patents Grants Charters Scripts writings and Manuscripts whatsoever concerning  
 the same To have and to hold of his land and Promisid to his s<sup>r</sup>. Gilbert Clark his heire and  
 Assignes for ever and the s<sup>r</sup>. Rebeka Dayly doth hereby for her selfe her heire Execut<sup>t</sup> Adm<sup>t</sup> Landman  
 Agree to and with his s<sup>r</sup>. Gilbert Clark his heire Execut<sup>t</sup> and Adm<sup>t</sup> that the s<sup>r</sup>. Rebeka Dayly  
 At the time of the sealing and Delivry of these presents shall be seized of the said land & promisid to his  
 appurtenances aforesaid true good and sufficient estate of inheritance in fee simple & that she  
 hath full right and good power and lawfull Authority to grant bargaine and sell of same to his
