 of the Dominion of Carlius absolute Lord & Proprietary of the Province of Maryland
 and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore & Anno Domini 1675 Between Thomas Philipps
 of the County of Calbot Planter & Mary his wife of the one part And Edward Man of the
 same County Merchant of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Philipps
 and Mary his wife as well for & in Consideration of the full sum or quantity of
 Eighteene thousand pounds of Good sound Merchantable tobacco in cashes unto
 and for him the said Thomas Philipps & his Assignes in hand already paid by him
 the said Edward Man wherof & wherewith he the said Thomas Philipps doth hereby
 Acknowledge himselfe fully satisfied contented & paid and thereof every part & part
 thereof doth clearly acquit & absolutely discharge him the said Edward Man
 his Assignes & Assignes for ever by these presents as for Divers other Good Causes
 and valuable Considerations from the said Thomas & Mary therunto moving Haue and
 either of them hath given Granted bargained Altered & Confirmed and by these presents
 Doe & either of them doth here Grant bargain sell Alien & Confirme unto him the said
 Edward Man his Assignes & Assignes All that Tract or parcel of Land lately surveyed
 called Killom or by what other name or names soever the same or any part or parts
 thereof is or are now or hath been called or knowne lying & being in the said County
 of Calbot on the North side of Choptank River there Beginning at a marked White
 Oak being the bounded head of a parcel of Land there formerly laid out for one Andrew
 Skinner Standing by the River by a Valley running North East up the said River two
 hundred Perches to a marked White Oak Standing at or near the mouth or Entrance
 of a certaine Creek there called or knowne by the name of Turkey Creeke being the bounded
 head of a parcel of Land there formerly laid out for one Ralph Williams & running from
 the said last mentioned Oak North West ffew hundred Ninety six Perches and with a
 line drawn from the End of the said North West line South West three hundred
 four Perches & with a line drawn from the End of the said South West line South
 East ffew hundred & Eighty Perches And with a line drawn from the End of the
 South East line North East one hundred & ffifty Perches And
 East by South one hundred & Sixty Perches to the said first
