 doth hereby acknowledge accordingly and himself to be thereof and therewith fully satisfied And
 the said Brunwin his heirs and assigns and of every of them by these presents doth the said
 Keyting hath granted bargained sold aliened, conveyed, and confirmed by these
 presents fully clearly and absolutely Grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm
