had or ought to have of, in or to the said plantation named and land thereunto belonging
talled Anketill above particularly mentioned or of in or to any part or part of them by
any ways or means whatsoever to have and to hold the same with his appurtenances good
and all herbs and all deeds and writings touching and concerning the same to him the said
Nicholas Stewall his heirs and assigns to the only use of the said Nicholas Stewall his heirs and
assigns for ever so that neither to the said Francis chustice his point nor his heirs nor any
other person or persons for him or them or in his or their names or in his name right or road
of them or any of them shall or will by any ways or means hereafter have haire reallonge
or demand any estate right title or interest of in or to the premises or any part or part of them
but from all and every maner right estate title interest and demand of in or to the premises or any
part or part of them by him shall be utterly excluded and disbarred by these
presentes, and also the said Francis chustice his point and his heirs the said plantation named lands
premises aforesaid talled chustice with his appurtenances to the said Nicholas Stewall his heirs and

Commonwealth of Charles absolute Lord and Proprietor of the Province of Maryland and Avalon Lord
Baron of Baltimore etc anno 1684 Between Thomas Keyting of St. Marys County in the Pro-
vince of Maryland Gent in the one part and Thomas Brumwell of the same County Gent on the other
part **Witnesseth** that for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty Thousand pounds of
goods sound merchantable tobacco and else to the said Thomas Keyting in hand paid and before
the sealing thereof by the said Thomas Brumwell was recd whereas the said Thomas Keyting
doth hereby acknowledge and himself to be thereto and therewith fully satisfied and
discharged and of every part thereof doth thereby acquit demands and discharge the said Thomas
Brumwell his heirs executors and of every of them by these presents **Agree** the said
Keyting hath granted bargained sold alured disengaged and confirmed by these
presentes fully cleared and absolutely granted bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm-
