 drawn South East from the said Pine in a Brant of the said Creek and by the  
 said Brants on the East by the said Creek containing land out and within, for  
 three hundred acres or more or less and all houses to the said messuage or  
 content land and premises and tract of land belonging or in any wise  
 appertaining to have and to hold the said messuage or content land  
 and premises with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said Thomas Grunwin  
 his heirs and assigns to him only use and behoof of the said Thomas Grunwin  
 his heirs and assigns for ever And the said Thomas Heving for him his &  
 heirs &c & administrators and for ever of him doth covenant grant and agree to

 and will at all times hereafter at and upon the reasonable request and att the  
 cost and charges in the law of the said Thomas Grunwin his heirs and assigns  
 make and grant unto him and them to his and their use further and other  
 apparent and unapparent tenuancy and copyancy for the further and more  
 better assuring and sure making of the said premises to the said Thomas Grunwin  
 and his heirs as by him or them or his or their commandes hearein in the law  
 shall be devised or advised and required in witness whereof the party abovesaid  
 to this indenture interchangably have putt their hands and sealed the day
