Call wchom these p[re]sents shall come Entitling knowe that upon the sixtenth day of April Anno Domini 1685 Anno Regni Regis 37. before me the last will and testament of William Priddy Mariner was proved approved and allowed of and the said Charles Goffe Executor in the said will nominated by the name of Charles Goffe is admitted to take into his custody and possession and to administer on all the goods and chattels due amount and other of the estate of the said deceased within first by publick and manifest known to all Judges Justices Charles Marshall and Bayliffs whatsoever the said Charles Goffe having been sworn to bring unto the Secretarys office within the said dayes a true and perfect Inventory of all and every the said deceaseds estate which shall or may come to his hands possession or knowledge first to be recorded and the said Charles Goffe is to pay all just debts due and to perform such other things as and by ought to be done according to Law Given under my hand and seal at Annapolis this twentieth day of April Anno Domini 1685 Anno Regni 37.

To all Christian People to whom these presents shall come greeting in our Lord God Everlasting knowe that I Daniel Prusse of Soudon Marryne have assigned or ordained and made and in my stead and place by these presents have put and constituted my trusty and well beloved friend and Cousin William Struvs of Summers County in the Province of Maryland to be my true and lawfull attorney for me and in my name and to my use to sell, let, or sell the Plantation called by the name of Shymantaker & situate lying and being on the Eastern shore in Pomoyne River in the Province aforesaid and the fort of Satter and bought thereunto belonging together with the same & to my said attorney for my self my heirs Executors Administrators ratify and confirm what my said attorney shall lawfully do in the premises and further desiring and empowering my said attorney to do what he thinks fit or law for the better securing of the title of the above said tract of Land and all charges about the settling and securing of the plantation aforesaid I do hereby promise to pay to my said attorney holding firm and stable all and whatsoever my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done in or about the premises by virtue of these presents as if I were then in mine own person present in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 21 day of April 1682
