 contayning any wayes regarding the effect had imported and brought in
 to the said province of Maryland and the said ship or vessel for several goods
 merchandizes ~~of the same~~ in the Schedule Statute amerced in divers and
 divers and sundry other goods and merchandizes bring all of them goods and
 merchandizes of the greatest production or manufacure of Europe whiche were
 not Italy and Spaine shipp'd hant or fashon in England Wales or the Cown
 of Normandy upon Englynd but were by the said Fauncis Scott shipp'd or hant or
 carri'd on board the said ship or vessel in the Kingdome of Scotland or Ireland and
 the same goods or merchandizes set at aforesaid Imported into this Province
 by the said Fauncis Scott did thene shane out of the said ship or vessel unload
 and putt a shone of the said Fauncis Scott not having first made entry of the said
 ship with the officer appointed by the said Governeour for that purpose
 or att any other time since and before delivery of full deliver or cause to be
 directed to the Governeour or the said officer by him therunto authorized
 appointed a true and perfect inventory invoyet or perteinante of the said
 goods or commodityes of the said ship's loading together with the place or place
 in whiche the said goods were loadt or fashon into the said ship or vessel as in
 and by the said Statute the said Fauncis Scott was required to pay unto the said
 the form of the Statute aforesaid in that case made and provided in the same
 the said Nicholas Dewall who as well for the said Lord the King as for the said Governeour
 as for himselfe prostitute in this behalfe prayte the admitt of the Court in the
 prmissed and that the said ship called the Governour of Londondry may be
 forfitte with all her Gunnes tales ammition furniture and appurtenances
 goods and commodityes imported as aforesaid according to the form of the Statute
 aforesaid and that the same forfeiture may be divided into three equal parts of
 our third part to our soueraigne lord the King our third part thereto to the
 said Lord Proprietary of the said Province and the other
 third part remayneth of the said forfeiture to him the said Nicholas Dewall Governor
 as aforesaid according to the form of the said Statute and that the said Fauncis Scott
 may come into Court and answer our said soueraigne lord the King for
 the said Governeour as aforesaid and the said Nicholas Dewall who as well for the said
 Lord the King the said Governeour as for himselfe in this behalfe prostitute of and
 upon the premises

The Court adjourned for an hour and then sat again Present as aforesaid

Fauncis Scott etiue legally summond appeared in Court and as commandre
 and master of the ship Governour aforesaid acknowledged the matter in the Informa-
 tion above alredyed to be true and that he submitte himselfe to the Judgment
 of the Court — Wherupon it is resolved by the Court that the
 commodityes goods wares and merchandizes in the Information and Schedule
 aforesaid in the ship aforesaid with all her Gunnes Cattell furniture ammition
 and appurtenances be lost and forfeited according to the form of the Statute aforesaid
 viz our third part thereto to our said soueraigne lord the King our other
 third part thereto to the Lord Proprietary aforesaid theif Governeour of this Province
 and the other third part thereto to the said Nicholas Dewall who as well for
 our soueraigne lord the King as the said Lord Proprietary theif Governeour of
 this Province as for himselfe prostitute according to the form of the Statute
 aforesaid
