 Nicholas Scwall of Walpert County in the Province of Maryland &  
 Henry Darwall of the same County & William Digges of St. xx  
 Maryland County q[ui] send greeting in our Lord God we rassing whereas  
 att a count of exchequerly held by speciall commissioun att the house of  
 Richard Lee in Portugal lxxv in the said County of Walpert the nine  
 & twentynre day of August last past before the Justices thereunto assynd  
 a certaine information was exhibitiion by the said Nicholas Scwall therin  
 collector to his most Excellent Majestie Fauncis the second of England Rore  
 ffraunce & Ireland King of the realme of all the Nations duteys  
 and impositions due and payable to his said Majestie in the said Province  
 of Maryland who as well for our said Sovereign Lord the Kings Majestie  
 that now is and the right Hon[or]ble the Lord Proprietary Gouverneur  
 of the said Province as for himselfe prosetteth Fauncis Rore  
 commandor of the shipp Albion or London dry in the Kingdome of  
 of England for estate of the ditt of Parliam[en]t for Exchequerly po[wer]e  
 made in the fiftene year of the Raigne of our late Sovreign Lord King  
 Edward the second of England memory declared the Justices of the said Court  
 did the day and yere aforesaid att Portugal lxxv aforesaid adiugit ex  
 equitatem the said shipp with all her gunnes Cattell ammition furniture  
 and apparel of all European goods to be losse or fritte for the estate of  
 the said aforesaid to be divided according to the law aforesaid into three  
 equal parts that is to say one third part thereto to our said Sovereign  
 Lord the Kings Majestie that now is, one third part to the said Lord Proprietary  
 Chifftourour aforesaid and the other third part to the said Nicholas  
 Scwall who as well for our said Sovereign Lord the King and the said  
 Lord Proprietary as for himselfe prosetteth aforesaid to be that the said  
 shipp was by commissioun from the said Court appraised to the sum of one  
 hundred, and fifty pounds of Lawfull mony of England Now itt be  
 wot for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds  
 of Lawfull mony of England to be in hand before the Justicing and  
 delivery thereto truly paid by Ninian Rocal & Thomas Brookes of the said  
 County of Walpert out of white sum: we do acknowledge the Recorde  
 by these presents that is to say the said Nicholas Scwall forth use of his  
 most Excellent Majestie the King that now is haue recd the sum offifty po  
 lawfull mony of England for his said Majestie third part for the shipp  
 Gunnes Cattell ammition furniture and apparel aforesaid to be  
 said Henry Darwall & William Digges other fifty pounds for the said  
 Lord Proprietary Chifftourour his third part and the said Nicholas  
 Scwall the other third part according to the true intent and meaning of  
 the Statute aforesaid haue bargained and sold and by these presents do  
 bargain & sel unto the said Ninian Rocal & Thomas Brookes the said shipp  
 called the Albion or London dry and the singular the Gunnes &  
 Cattell ammition furniture apparel to the said shipp belonging or  
 haue all to hold the said shipp and all and singular the Gunnes &  
 Cattell ammition furniture apparel aforesaid to them the said  
 Ninian Rocal & Thomas Brookes their decommis[er]es assigned to a  
 for their only proper use and behoof for ever In testimony whereof
