I know all men by these presents that I Thomas Gavan citizen and inhabitant of Charles
County in the Province aforesaid am being by Gods grace suddenly
bound on a voyage for England for divers good reasons and considerations
whereunto especially mooring Hanc (in my absent) made ordained and
constituted and by these presents do make ordaine and constitute my much
esteemed friend Francis Pennington of St. Michaels County in the Province
aforesaid to be my true and lawfull Attorney for me and in my name
and to my owne proper use and behoove to assay demand sue for heavy recompence
and receive all due debts and demands that come or shall be due to me
upon any account or by any means from any person or persons whatsoever
and acquittances or other sufficient discharge for the same in my name to
make scale and deliver and to doe all other act and unto thing and things
concerning or relating to any of my affaires in the said Province as fully
and simply as if I my self being personally present might or could doe and
Attorney or Attorneys under him to substitute and appoint for the prosecution
of any of my affaires and at his pleasure to recuse hereby ratifying and
confirming whatsoever my said Attorney or any under him shall doe by vertue
of these presents In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and scale
this twenty third day of April anno domini 1686
