Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Gavan cutt p'sent of Charles County in the Province aforesaid being by Gods grace suddenly bound on a voyage for England for divers good causes and considerations me hereunto especially movinge (and in my absence) made ordained and constituted and by these presents doe make ordaine and constitute my most esteemed friend Francis Pennington of St. Maryes County in the Province aforesaid Cutt my true and lawfull Attorney for me and in my name and to my owne proper use and behoofe to ask demand sue for recovery and receive all due debts and demands that are or shall be due to me upon any account or by any means from any person or persons whatsoever and acquitted or other sufficient discharged for the same in my name to make sale and deliver and to doe all other act and unto thing and things touching or relating to any of my affaires in the said Province as fully and amply as if I my self being personally present might or could doe And Attorney or Attorneys under him to substitute and appoint for the prosecution of any of my Affaires and all his pleasure to revoke hereby ratifying and confirming whatsoever my said Attorney or any under him shall doe by vertue of these presents In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty third day of April Anno Domini 1686
