 Know all men by these presents that I <sup>Wm</sup> Louger of the Island of Barbados aforesaid Merchant, for divers goods and valuable Considerations made hereunto moving here made ordained constituted appointed and in my stead and place put and deputed and by these presents doe make doe make Authorize constitute appoint and in my stead and in my place put and depute my trusty and well beloved friend the hon<sup>ble</sup> <sup>Wm</sup> Hoovers Esq<sup>r</sup> of Maryland, my true and lawfull Attorney and for me and in my name to aff<sup>d</sup> demand and sue for Levy require recover and receive all such sumes and sumes of money tobacco goods wares Merchandizes of what quality soever be due unto me by bill bond, book, Consign<sup>ts</sup> or otherwise from any manner of person whatsoever giving and hereby granting unto my said Attorney my full and whole power and Authority to Impound Arrest attach & imprison such person or persons that shall refuse to account or make satisfaction and all the pleasure of my said Attorney against to release acquittances and other discharges for me and in my name (if neede be to signe seals and Execute one or more Attorneys under him to make and substitute (if occasion require with like and limited power Ratiifying, allowing and Confirming all and whatsoever my said Attorney shall lawfully doe in the premises for value to all intent and purposes whatsoever as if Constitutor were personally present in witness whereof I have to this Letter of Attorney sett my hand Seale this seventh day of April one thousand six hundred Eighty five.

Betweene Thomas Sympson Son<sup>r</sup> of St Maries County in the said province of Maryland planter on the one part and Thomas Sympson Sen<sup>r</sup> of the same County Sonne & heire apparant of the said Thomas the Elder on the other part Witnesseth that for the naturall love & affection which the said Thomas Sympson the Elder beareth unto his said Sonne Thomas Sympson & for the sume of five shillings by the said Thomas Sympson the younger for the said Thomas the Elder in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Thomas the Elder And for divers other good causes and Considerations him the said Tho<sup>s</sup> Sympson the Elder then unto moving that the said Thomas Sympson the Elder shall give granted bargainod sold Enfeoffed and Confirmed And by these presents both fully freely clearly and Absolutely give grant bargainod sold Enfeoffed & Confirmed unto the said Thomas Sympson the younger & his heires for ever All that Messuages or tenements and plantation situate lying & being in St Maries County aforesaid now in the
