This Indenture made the eighth day Day off September In the offour Lord one thousand six hundred Eighty and, five Betwene Philip Willian off<sup>s</sup> t Maryes County planter on the one part and Phillip Lynes off<sup>s</sup> t Maryes County aforesaid merchant on the other part witnesseth that for & in Consideracion off the sume off six thousand pounds off tobacco to the said philip Willian in hand paid before the sealing hereoff by the said Phillip Lynes the receipt where off the said philip Willian doth hereby acknowledge accordingly and himselfe there off & therewith fully satisfied bee the said philip Willian hath granted & bargained sold aliened Enfeoffed and Confirmed & into the said Phillip Lynes and his heires all that tract or piece off Land situated Lying & being in Charles County in the said province off Maryland in the Woods about three mile from the Eastermost branch Nangemij or aken River and about three mile to the North ward off the Land formerly belonging to George Thompson gent<sup>r</sup> and about one mile from the Southermost branch off St Thomas or Mattawomen Creek beginning at a marshd oak standing upon the side off a hill opposite to Natiuge bouding on the west by alme drawn south for breadth two hundred and fifty perches to a marked posthirij on the south by alme drawn East from the said posthirij for length of three hundred and twenty perches to a marked oak by a swamp on the East by alme drawn north from the said oak untill itt intersect a paralled from the first marshd oak on the hill on the North by the said paralell Conkyning and Layed out for five hundred acres more or less of the said Land was
