and also a young Cow and her Increase, and a feather Bed and furniture  
to the same, and a New Iron Pot, and a New frying pan, and a New  
Bowler Dish

Item Three years schooling a piece, for my two sons, and to be brought up  
in the Romane Catholick Religion, and that no account be brought  
against my said Children when they come to age, In Witness whereof  
We have hereunto set our hands this Ninth of July 1685
