This Indenture Made the two & twentieth day of february in the seventh
 year of the Dominion of Charles absolute Lord & propriarij of the provinces
 of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. annoq^o Dni: 1637
 Between Robert Mason of s^t Maries County in the province of
 Maryland of the one Part and John Biscoe of the aforesaid County
 and Province of the other Part Wittneseth that the said Robert
 Mason for and in Consideration of the Just quantity sixteen thousand
 pounds of good Tobacco: and Caske to him paid before the sealing and
 Deliverij here of by the said John Biscoe: the Receipt where of the said
 Robert Mason doth here by acknowledge, and himselfe there wth fully
 satis fied Contented and paid and thereof and Everij Part and part ther of
 Doth hereby absolutely and Clearly Exonerate acquit and discharge the
 said John Biscoe his heires Ex^{te} and adm^{rs} for Ever By these presents hath
 Given granted Bargained aliene sold Enfeoffed and Confirmed and by
 these presents Doth fully Clearly and absolutely given grant Bargained alien
 sell Enfeoffe and Confirme unto him the said John Biscoe his heires &
 assigns for Ever all his Right Title and Interest of that piece or tract
 of Land situated Lying and being to the Westward of the clear ground
 of William asbestons plantation upon Deep Creeke in s^t Michael hundred
 Beginning att a Marked Gum Near adjoined to the Line of James Lewes
 and Bruning East south East unto a marked white oake Neare unto the
 orchard of said William asbeston Not far Distant from a bounded Pine
 of the said asbestons plantation and from the afo^{re} oake unto a Marked
 Sassafras from thence to a Marked Locus from thence to a Marked
 Dogwood from thence to a Marked white oake from thence to a Marked
 Chestnut Neare upon Deep Creeke all wth six Last Mentioned trees Lying
 along the clear ground of the said William asbestons plantation and
 Bruning from the aforesaid Chestnut on the Mayne Branch of Deep Creeke
 Due west unto a marked Pickchery from thence up said Branch to a
 Marked white oake and from thence Bruning south south East to the first
 Mentioned Gum: Containing and now laid out for fifty acres More or
 Less; and Likewise all that Barrell or tract of Land situated Lying & being
 on the North side of the aforesaid ~~Branch~~ Mayne Branch off
 Deepe Creeke in the aforesaid hundred and County formerly belonging
