the said place planter on the other part Wittnesse that the said Thomas
Simpson for & in consideration of five thousand pounds of Tobacco in Caske
to him the said Thomas Simpson before the Ensealing & Delivery of these
Presents, by the said Robert Hagar well and truly paid the receipt the
said Thomas Simpson doth hereby acknowledge & himself there wth fully
satisfied & Contented and of Every part & parcell thereof doth clearly acquit
Exonorate and Discharge the said Robert Hagar his heires Ex^{ors} adm^{ors} &
Every of them, by these Presents hath given, granted, aliened, bargained
sold assigned Transferrd Enfeoffed & Confirmed and by these Presents
Doth give grant alien, bargain sell assigne trasfer Enfeoffe & Con firme
vnto him the said Robert Hagar his heires and assignes for Ever all that
Parcell or tract of Land lying situate & being in s^t Maryes County being
part of a parcell of Land called s^t Georges, beginning at a bounded stake of m^d
Marmaducke summs standing on the West side of Piles fresh and bounding
Upon the said summs West & by South three hundred and twenty Berches
to two bound trees the one a Red stake the other a dogwood thence south
& by East fifty pches to a bounded white stake thence East & by North, three
hundred & twenty pches to the side of piles fresh thence binding wth the
fresh as the fresh summs to the first bounded tree: Containing one hundred
Acres more or less together with all houses Edifices buildings structures
Orchard Gardens Fishings & foulings & all & singular other appurtenances
and priviledges, to the said Land belonging or in any manner of way
appurtenant TO HAVE and to hold the said Land & premises wth their &
