my seale dated the first Day of December annoq. Domini: 1686.

The Condition of this present above written obligation: is such that if the above  
Bound John Lewellin his heires: Ex<sup>rs</sup> adm<sup>s</sup> and assigns and Euery of them  
shall and Doo from time time and att all tymes for Euer here after well and  
truly obserue performe fulfill and keep all and singular the Couenants graunt  
Bargaines articles Causes and agreements Mentioned and Expressed in: one  
Certaine Indenture of bargain and sale bearing Euen Date w<sup>th</sup> the above  
Written obligation had and made by & betwene the above bounden John

Which on the part and behalfe of the said John Lewellin his heires Ex<sup>rs</sup>  
adm<sup>s</sup> and assigns are to be obserued performe fulfill & kept and

This present above written obligation shall bee voyd and of None Effect other  
wise to stand and remaine in full force strength and vertue
