 discharge and Acquittances for the same or any part thereof for me and in my
 name to make and Deliver. And also to doe Perform and Execute all and every
 other Lawfull and Reasonable Acts and things whatsoever both for Obteyning
 and discharging of the same as shall be needfull to be done Giving and by
 these presents Granting unto my said Attorney my full and absolute Power
 in the premises Rectifying and Holding firm all and whatsoever my sd. Attorney
 shall doe or cause to be done in or about the Premises by Vertue of these presents
